Formal vs Informal sector

Characteristics	Informal Sector	Formal Sector
Ease of Entry	Lower “barriers to entry”	Higher “barriers to entry”
Resource Use	Usually local resources	Domestic and sometimes foreign resources (material and managerial)
Scale of Operation	Micro to small	Micro, small, medium and large
Financing	Personal or family savings, and maybe micro-credits	Domestic or foreign financial institutions, foreign enterprises, or public sources
Technology	Relatively labour intensive	Relatively capital intensive
Organization	Self-employment, family oriented	Corporate, “modern,” bureaucratic
Skill Acquisition	Informal apprenticeships, outside formal school system	Formal educational system
Labour Market	Competitive, non-unionized and unregulated	Less competitive, perhaps unionized, regulated, minimum wage laws
Taxation	Usually untaxed, except for licensing	Taxed
Regulation	Mainly unregulated	Regulated: health and safety, labour legislation, environmental regulations
Public Policy	Unprotected, less assisted via credit, tariffs, tax incentives, infrastructure	Often protected and assisted via credit, infrastructure provision, tax incentives

Informal Sector

- Business not registered
- Do not pay taxes
- Do not keep accurate record of business activities
- Long working hours
- Low wages paid
- Employees rights not protected

Capital crisis

- Delhi's air quality deteriorates(गिरावट)
- Suffocating(घुटना) smog
- State governments do not act-> Sense of urgency.
- Turned into a public health emergency in the capital
- Burning of biomass in Punjab and Haryana.

- Many such initiatives were taken up by China in its cities to reduce exposure to PM2.5 that produces morbidity(रोगों की संख्या) from
 - ✓ 1)-Cardiovascular (Relating to the heart and blood)
 - ✓ 2)-Respiratory(श्वसन) diseases and
 - ✓ 3)-Leads to premature death.
- ✓ Sustainable residue removal cannot be achieved by the farmers alone, and requires help from the state machinery
- ✓ Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981
- ✓ Only a determined response to the crisis can spare Delhi of its infamous tag as one of the most polluted cities on the planet.

Air Quality Index Levels of Health Concern	Numerical Value	Meaning
Good	0 to 50	Air quality is considered satisfactory, and air pollution poses little or no risk.
Moderate	51 to 100	Air quality is acceptable; however, for some pollutants there may be a moderate health concern for a very small number of people who are unusually sensitive to air pollution.
Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups	101 to 150	Members of sensitive groups may experience health effects. The general public is not likely to be affected.
Unhealthy	151 to 200	Everyone may begin to experience health effects; members of sensitive groups may experience more serious health effects.
Very Unhealthy	201 to 300	Health warnings of emergency conditions. The entire population is more likely to be affected.
Hazardous	301 to 500	Health alert: everyone may experience more serious health effects.

'Like the Great Smog of London'

20% rise in patients seeking treatment for respiratory issues

As air pollution hit alarming levels in Delhi, major city hospitals on November 8 experienced a surge in the number of patients complaining of respiratory problems with AIIMS Director Randeep Guleria comparing the situation to the killer Great Smog of London in 1952.

Dr. Guleria stressed on implementation of long-term measures to tackle the crisis.

There was a spurt in fresh cases in hospitals and conditions of patients with history of asthma, Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disorder (COPD) and cardiovascular diseases deteriorated.

Breathlessness, coughing
Patients have started coming to the OPDs with complaints of breathlessness, coughing, sneezing, tightness in chest, allergy and asthma complications.

"There is about 20 per cent rise in patients seeking treatment due to respiratory and cardiac issues" said Dr

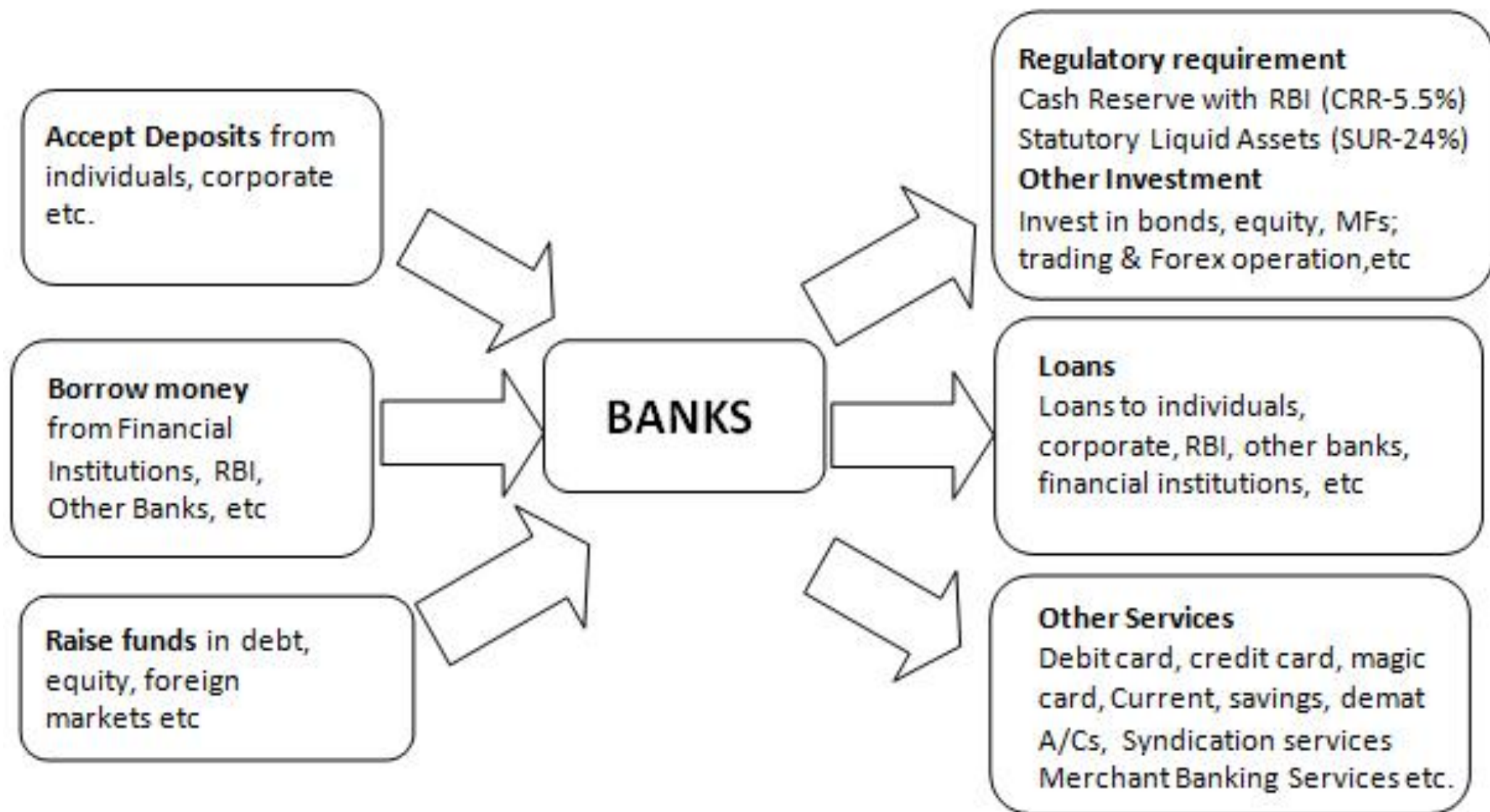

Right to privacy as right to life

GN Saibaba has been given life sentence by a court in Maharashtra's Gadchiroli for his **links with the Maoists**

No one understands 90% disabled person is behind bars struggling with one hand in condition and suffering with multiple ailments

- 2014, Delhi University professor **G.N. Saibaba** was arrested under the **Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act**
- **Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2013**, respect for inherent dignity, individual autonomy



"In custody, disabled persons must be protected from any hindrance to the exercise of bodily integrity and autonomy with dignity." Professor G.N. Saibaba after being released from Nagpur Central Jail. ■S. SUDARSHAN

Right to privacy as right to life

- Supreme Court's **right to privacy judgment**
- ***Justice K.S. Puttaswamy v. Union of India***
- Life and personal **liberty**(स्वतंत्रता)- **inalienable**(अविच्छेद्य) to human existence
- **A constitutional democracy** can survive when citizens have an undiluted assurance that the rule of law will protect their rights and liberties
- **Judicial remedies** would be available to ask searching questions and expect answers when a citizen has been deprived of these most rights."
- Articles 14, 19 and 21
- Privacy-as an **integral part of the right to human dignity** is comprehended within the **protection of life** as well.

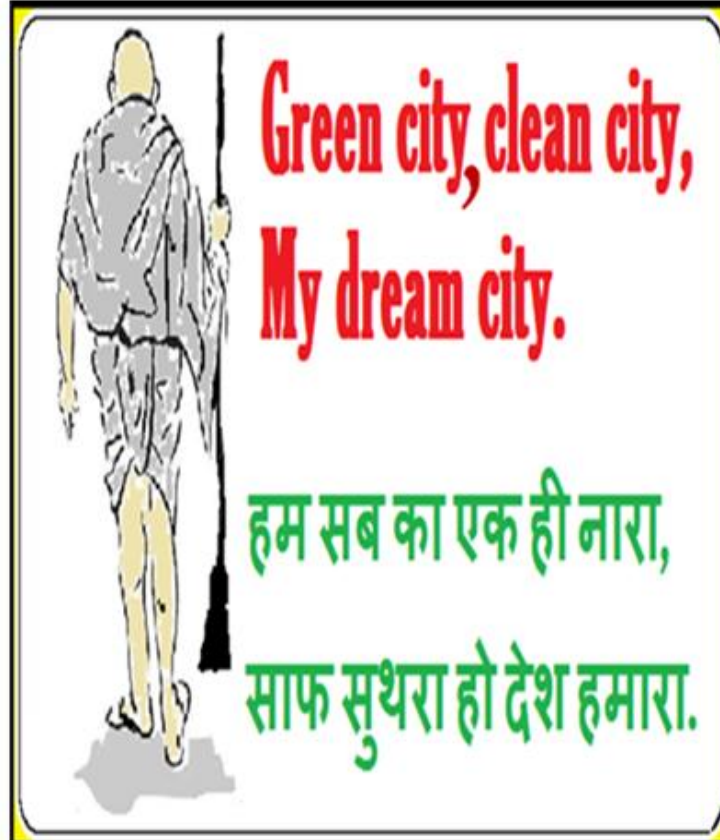
